RESOLUTION OF GOVERNMENT.

Government is pleased to constitute an Ad hoc Board of the following members to advise Government in matters connected with the training in Marathi of Government servants who do not know Marathi or have inadequate knowledge of Marathi and for the conduct of examinations in Marathi for them:-

Director of Languages, Maharashtra State.	Chairman

Shri C.D.Dange, Professor, Tilak College of Education, Poona.	Member
Shri S.M.Muktibodh, Lecturer, Nagpur Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur.	Member
Deputy Director of Languages, Maharashtra State, (Training & Establishment).	Member-Secretary.

The Deputy Director of Languages (Training and Establishment) should act as Secretary of the Ad hoc Board.

2. The functions of the above Ad hoc Board should be as follows:-

- (i) to compile a book on Marathi Grammar;
- (ii) to evolve methods of teaching Marathi to persons who do not know Marathi or do not have adequate knowledge of Marathi for purpose of official work in Marathi Language.
- (iii) to frame rules and syllabus for the training of such persons.
- (iv) to recommend books to be prescribed for the examination in Marathi.
- (v) to suggest rules for the holding of Marathi examination for such persons and to make when required, all arrangements for holding the examination including appointment of paper setters, examiners, supervisors, conductors, selection of centres and publication of results of the examination.

3. The Official members should be eligible for travelling allowance according to the normal rules. The non-official members should be held eligible for Travelling Allowance and Daily Allowance as admissible under scale I in Rule I(i)(b) in Appendix XIII-A (Section-I) to the

time. The Director of Languages should be the countersigning authority

in respect of travelling allowance status of non-official members of the Ad hoc Board.

4. The non-official members of the Ad hoc Board should be paid sitting fees of Rs.12.50 (Rupees Twelve and fifty naye paise only) per meeting per day, subject to the general orders that may be issued by Government in the matter hereafter.

5. The expenditure on this account should be debited to the budget head "19-C.K.-General Administration-C-Secretariat and Attached offices-K-Civil Secretariat-K-2(i) Director of Languages" and should be met from grants sanctioned for the year 1962-63 thereunder.

6. This resolution issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide un-official reference No.1599/97-V, dated the 6th February 1963.
