
CIRCULAR

The Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice and Judges have directed me to invite attention of all Judicial Officers working in Subordinate Courts to Government Notification dated 30<sup>th</sup> April, 1966 which is reproduced below paragraph 45(6) of Chapter VI of the Criminal Manual and also Government Notification dated 21<sup>st</sup> July, 1998 which is published in the Government Gazette and a copy whereof is annexed herewith.

All the Judicial Officers working in Subordinate Courts are directed to follow the provision contained in paragraph 45(6) of Chapter VI of the Criminal Manual and paragraph 254 of Chapter X and paragraph 268 of Chapter XI of the Civil Manual and also the instructions contained in the Government notification dated 21<sup>st</sup> July, 1998. The Judicial Officers are expected to transact 50% of court business, including writing of judgments in Marathi language and in particular, in the matters pertaining to application u/s 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, private complaint cases, cases u/s 138 of the N. I. Act, simple money suits and alike matters.

All the District Judges are directed to take a special note of the work done by Subordinate Judicial Officers in Marathi language, during course of inspection of such courts, and also in the annual confidential reports. The judicial work done in Marathi language will be duly appreciated by the High Court.
